



Riverside views

The Interim Olympics Delivery Agency has revealed these images of how the Lower Lea Valley will look in just six years time.

The plans, which were developed by the Edaw consortium which helped win the Olympic bid and has now

been appointed as official Olympic Park masterplanner, centre on a linear park running the length of the river Lea to the

Thames. The 202ha site has been described as the “heart of London’s plans for the 2012 games”.

The linear park will incorporate nine new venues, including the 80,000-seat Olympic Stadium, as well as the

Aquatics Centre designed by Zaha Hadid, the velodrome, a media centre and the Olympic Village.
