Pioneering UK wind turbines to be launched in Germany

quietrevolution™, manufacturer of the world's only turbine specifically designed to be safely situated where people live and work, has signed an exclusive agreement with RWE Innogy, a leading electricity and gas company in Europe and the market-leading power producer in Germany.

Maeve Hurley, CEO of quietrevolution said: "To enter into a sales partnership with one of Europe's largest utility companies is an exciting step forward for the business. This represents a new stage in our growth and is a clear indication of the growing demand for renewable technologies."

quietrevolution has been striving for over four years to design a product that is low noise, low vibration and safe when sited close to people. The innovative qr5 turbine, manufactured and assembled in South Wales, is geared towards adding visual appeal to its surroundings and actually improves performance with increased wind turbulence. The qr5 is especially suited for generating power on-site and its compact rotor design, only 5x3 metres, means it can be installed either on buildings or as a stand-alone turbine. Around 120 qr5 wind turbines have been installed at sites in the UK and a further 40 are due to be installed over the next twelve months.

Two qr5 turbines have been commissioned in Essen, Germany and a further four turbines will be installed in the coming months. The agreement committed to by RWE Innogy is to sell up to 100 turbines in Germany by the end of 2011.



Dr. Olaf Heil, Director Hydro Power and New Applications of RWE Innogy said: “We are very happy to promote the qr5 turbine in Germany. We think the turbine will operate well in the German market and we have spoken to several interested potential clients which is very encouraging.”
